



MASTER'S DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM AGREEMENT BETWEEN

INSTITUT TEKNOLOGI SEPULUH NOPEMBER (Surabaya, Indonesia)

AND

COLLEGE OF MANAGEMENT, NATIONAL YUNLIN UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE
AND TECHNOLOGY (Yunlin, Taiwan R.O.C)

This Master's Dual Degree Program Agreement is between National Yunlin University of Science and Technology, Yunlin, Taiwan R.O.C (hereinafter referred to as YunTech) and Institut Teknologi Sepuluh Nopember, Surabaya, Indonesia (hereinafter referred to as ITS). Appendices may be added upon mutual consent.

Article 1 Definition

In this Agreement unless the context otherwise specifies:

"Home Institution" designates the institution sending the students."

"Host Institution" designates the institution receiving the students."

Article 2 Purpose

- i) The purpose of this agreement is to set out the terms and conditions under which ITS, shall provide the Master's Dual Degree Program, along with YunTech, and award MBA degree, Master of Science (MS) degree and other Master's degrees to both ITS and YunTech students. The Master's Dual Degree Program for qualified ITS and YunTech students will be developed through mutual cooperation between ITS and YunTech.
- ii) This agreement is intended to promote mutual cooperation between ITS and YunTech to help achieve goals and objectives of each and both parties, including competencies in management, as well as language proficiency, professional and research experiences.

Article 3 Qualification, Application, Length, and Credits Transference

- i) Students accepted and enrolled in the Master Programs at both ITS and YunTech are eligible to apply for this program. All students who apply for this program must then

follow the regular application procedures at the host institution.

- ii) The education period at not only host but also home institution shall be a minimum of two semesters or the equivalent.
- iii) To be granted a Master's degree from the home institution, students shall
 - (1) meet the graduation requirements of the home institutions
 - (2) complete at the home institution at least half of the credits required by the home institution
 - (3) be eligible to transfer up to half credits required by the home institution from the host institution.
- iv) To be granted a Master's degree from the host institution, students shall
 - (1) meet the graduation requirements of the host institutions
 - (2) complete at the host institution at least half of the credits required by the host institution
 - (3) be eligible to transfer up to half credits required by the host institution from the home institution.
- v) The list of courses that will fulfill degree requirements will be provided in separate documents. Credits Transference documents agreed upon by the directors or committees of graduate programs in two institutions are attached as appendixes to the Agreement.
- vi) Periods of study at the two institutions do not have to be continuous. Graduates are to receive dual degrees, one from each university.

Article 4 Educational Support and Others

- i) ITS and YunTech students will be responsible for the full cost of their education (i.e. application fees, tuitions, and student fees) as well as all living costs.
- ii) For enrollment, grade evaluations, scholarships, student services, student code of conduct, advising, and other related matters, the applicable regulations for each university shall be observed. For other matters, regulations from both universities will be followed. Enrolled students are eligible for applying the financial assistance provided by ITS and YunTech as below:
 - (1) YunTech provides qualified students one of the following financial assistances based on each applying student's academic performance. The financial assistance period is up to 1 year for students participating in the program.
 - Full scholarship: full tuition waive plus up to NT\$ 10,000 scholarship per month.
 - Partial scholarship: full tuition waive plus up to NT\$ 6,000 scholarship per month.
 - Tuition waive: there are implementation modalities: Full tuition waive, Half tuition waive, Quarter tuition waive.

- (2) ITS provides qualified students one of the following financial assistances based on each applying student's academic performance. The financial assistance period is up to 1 year for students participating in the program.
 - Full scholarship: full tuition waive plus up to 2,750,000 IDR scholarship per month.
 - Full Tuition Waive.
- (3) YunTech and ITS may provide scholarship scheme on competitive basis in various form.
- iii) Both ITS and YunTech are required to provide detailed information regarding the school environment and facilities for the qualified degree-seeking students.
- iv) Under the agreement, YunTech shall provide appropriate academic services for the ITS students. The education programs shall include the following:
 - (1) Each ITS student will be assigned an academic advisor and they will meet periodically to discuss academic matters and any other issues and concerns;
 - (2) ITS students can transfer the credits from YunTech according to ITS regulations after they take the classes at YunTech.
- v) Under the agreement, ITS shall provide appropriate and academic services for YunTech students. The program shall include the following:
 - (1) Each YunTech student will be assigned an academic advisor and they will meet periodically to discuss academic matters and any other issues and concerns;
 - (2) YunTech students can transfer the credits from ITS according to YunTech regulations after they take the classes at ITS.

Article 5 Housing and Other Facilities

- i) ITS students will be responsible for accessing suitable housing and transportation while studying at YunTech, with assistance from the host school. Each ITS student is responsible for the costs involved for services and accommodations.
- ii) YunTech shall provide guidance to ITS students in the use of various incidental facilities of the YunTech Yunlin, including libraries, computer labs, and other general university facilities.
- iii) YunTech students will be responsible for accessing suitable housing and transportation while studying at ITS, with assistance from the ITS. Each YunTech student is responsible for the costs involved for services and accommodations.
- iv) ITS shall provide guidance to YunTech students in the use of various incidental facilities of the ITS, Surabaya, including libraries, computer labs and other general university facilities.

Article 6 Health and Accident Insurance

ITS students at YunTech, YUNLIN are required to purchase the YunTech, YUNLIN mandatory health insurance coverage for which they may be automatically billed upon registration at YunTech, YUNLIN. YunTech students at ITS, Surabaya are required to purchase the ITS, Surabaya mandatory health insurance coverage for which they may be automatically billed upon registration at ITS, Surabaya.

Article 7 Communication and Consultation

Regular communication regarding the Master ' s Dual Degree program will be enacted between designates at YunTech and ITS.

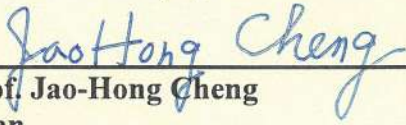
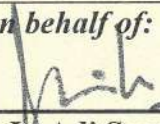
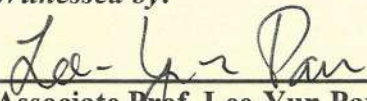
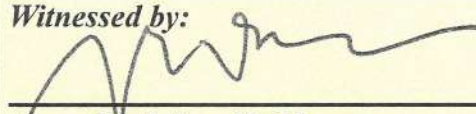
Article 8 Management of Students

- i) YunTech and ITS students shall comply with the academic and other regulations of the university of enrollment.
- ii) Applicants shall follow the regulations of the program requirements effective at the time of first enrollment at the home university.
- iii) For suspension and reinstatement of study, applicants must follow the applicable regulations of both universities.

Article 9 Effective Period and Others

- i) This Agreement may be modified through the mutual discussion and consent of the both parties, and shall remain in effect from the date of signature for an initial period of five years. However, after the initial period either university may terminate the agreement by giving six months written notice of such intent. Upon termination of this agreement by either party, YunTech and ITS students shall not be put at a disadvantage in any way until their degree program is completed.
